

The City of Grovetown has adopted new guidelines and procedures for bulk waste and yard debris collection. Starting October 2nd, 2017, the following will apply.

***The City will be on a bi-weekly pickup schedule. Please refer to the back of this sheet for your area's pickup dates. ***

- Owners of Apartments, rental homes/mobile homes, etc. will be responsible for disposal of eviction debris.
- Owners of Apartments, rental homes/mobile homes, etc. will be responsible for disposing of any renovation and / or construction debris.
- Lawn companies, private contractors, etc. who are hired to do yard work at a residence and / or business will be responsible for hauling off the debris.
- Leaf machine will run starting November 1st and will continue through March 31st of each year. The rest of the year leaves shall be bagged in biodegradable bags.
- Limbs or logs must not exceed 6" in diameter, the limb pile must not be larger than 5 feet long, 5 feet wide, and 5 feet high.

Monday – *Summer*: Grass clippings, yard debris / *Winter*: Bulk waste pickup, leaves.

Tuesday – *Summer*: Grass clippings, yard debris / *Winter*: Bulk waste pickup, leaves.

Wednesday – Household recycling: newspaper, cardboard boxes, aluminum cans.

Thursday – *Summer*: Bulk waste pickup, / *Winter*: Bulk waste pickup, leaves, limbs, yard waste.

Friday – Moving boxes from neighborhoods.

Summer - April 1 st - October 31 st Winter - November 1 st – March 31 st

Bulk Waste

Bulk waste consists of household items that are too large to reasonably fit in the garbage can. The most common examples of bulk waste are furniture, carpeting, mattresses and appliances (white goods).

Bulk waste do's and don'ts

- The bulk waste must be neatly stacked in a pile and not scattered, it must be placed away from vehicles, poles, mail boxes, and other obstructions adjoining your property.
- Carpet, padding, and rugs should be cut and rolled into (3) three-foot sections and tied or taped and weigh no more than 40 pounds.
- White goods (appliances) will be picked up, but all doors **must** be removed for safety purposes.
- For items that contain glass and or mirrors please extensively tape and cross tape the glass and or mirrors to prevent it from shattering.

What we cannot collect

- Hazardous waste, dirt, shingles, fuel/oil containers.
- Paint or any liquid items.
- Batteries of any type.
- Debris from work performed by anyone other than the resident.
- Building materials from a contractor.
- Materials from evictions, foreclosures, unoccupied properties, any renovation or remodeling debris from commercial properties, apartment complexes, rental homes, or rental mobile homes.
- Tires.
- Debris of any type from vacant lots.

Yard Debris

Yard debris includes inert and organic waste generated during regular household landscaping and gardening activities.

Examples: leaves, branches, twigs, shrubbery trimming, pine straw, grass clippings, Christmas trees.

***Rocks, dirt, and gravel are not considered yard debris.**

Yard Debris Do's and Don'ts

- Leaves, grass clippings, etc. must be placed in Bio-Degradable bags that weigh no more than 40 pounds and can be easily lifted by the average person.
- Yard debris must be free of other solid waste.
- No more than 20 bags shall be placed at the curb for collection at any one time.
- Yard debris should be kept at least 3 feet away from other collection items and obstacles such as mailboxes, poles, vehicles, etc.
- Yard debris should not be placed in the curb and gutter or around any storm drain structure that may impede the flow of storm water.
- Yard debris should not block any sidewalk.
- Separate brush, limb, and logs into piles no larger than 5 five feet long, and 5 five feet wide, and 5 five feet high.
- Logs or limbs must be 6 six inches of diameter or less.
- The City of Grovetown does not pick up yard debris generated by a private contractor performing tree removal or trimming at your home. The contractor is responsible for removing all waste.
- Yard debris shall not be mixed with other types of solid waste.

What we cannot collect.

- Dirt, rock, gravel, stumps.
- Material generated from a private contractor.

Grass cycling

What is grass cycling? It is recycling your grass clippings by leaving them on your lawn instead of collecting them with a grass catcher. It's an easy way to reduce yard waste and decrease your grass cutting time. Mulched grass decomposes quickly, returning nutrients back into your grass. The City of Grovetown encourages our Citizen's to take part in this. It saves on valuable manpower, and valuable landfill space.

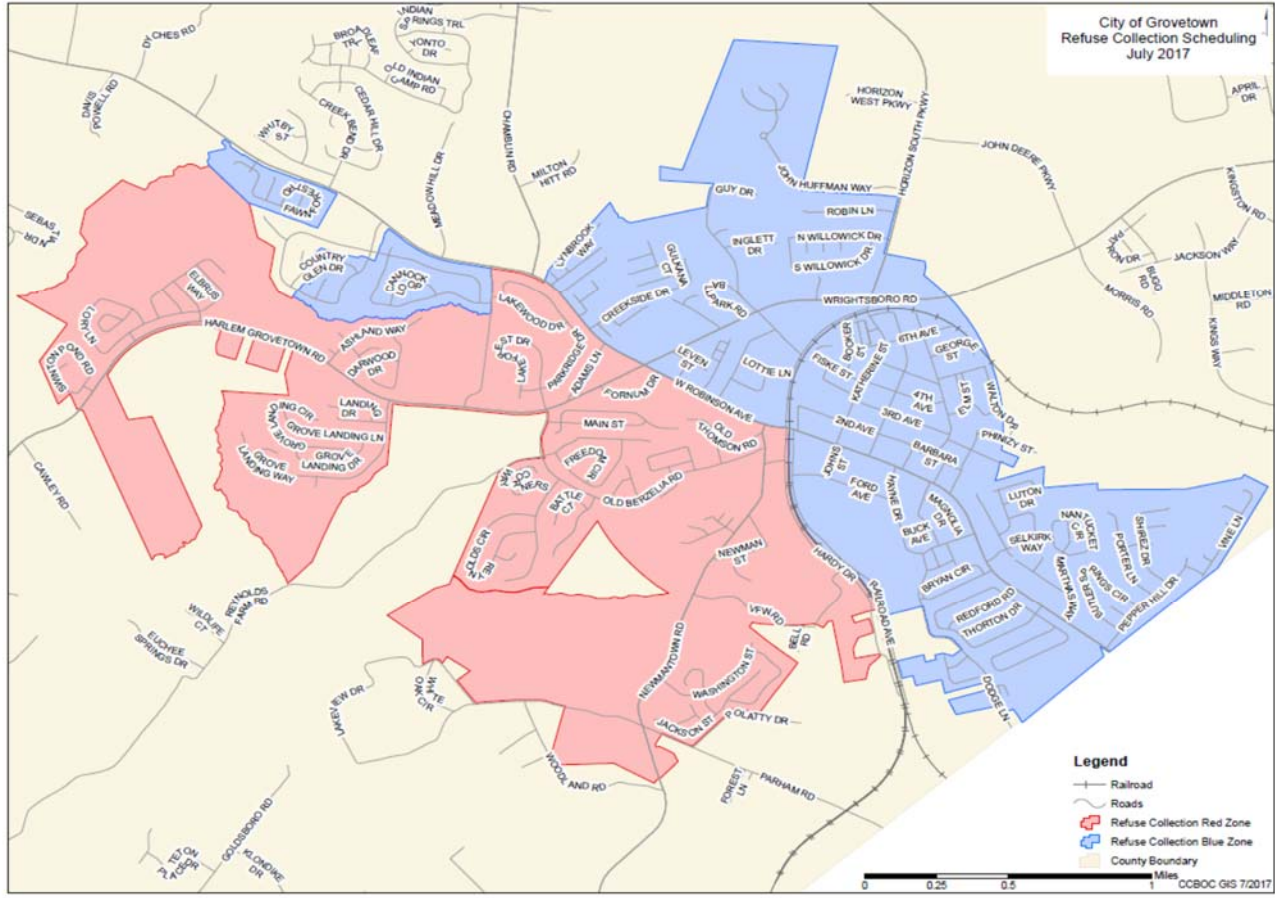
