Front end repair cost \$700 dollars

ECM cost \$900 dollars

Blue book value of vehicle \$1600 dollars

Recommend vehicle be sold as surplus

1999 Ford F150- vehicle needs transmission and steering column.

Transmission repair \$1,600 dollars

Steering column \$1,200 dollars

301,000 miles

Blue book value of vehicle \$800 dollars

Recommend vehicle be sold as surplus

The vehicles listed are in poor mechanical condition and cannot be used until major repairs have been done. All vehicles would exceed well past there book value if such repairs are done and are no longer usable for their intended purpose.
