## **Guidelines and Procedures for Bulk Waste and Yard Debris Collection**

**Please refer to the back of this sheet for your pickup dates**

- Owners of apartments, rental homes, rental mobile homes, etc. will be responsible for: Disposal of eviction debris and for disposal of any renovation and/or construction debris.
- Lawn companies, private contractors, etc. hired to do yard work at a residence and/or business will be responsible for disposing of the debris.
- Limbs or logs must not exceed 6" in diameter and limb piles must not be larger than 5 feet long, 5 feet wide, and/or 5 feet high.

**The Leaf Machine will run Nov. 1st–Feb. 28th in the areas of the City to be picked up that week.**

**From Mar. 1st–Oct. 31st, leaves need to be bagged.**

### **Bulk Waste - We no longer will pick up refrigerators, freezers, or air conditioners of any type.**

Bulk waste consists of household items that are too large to reasonably fit in the garbage can. The most common examples of bulk waste are furniture, carpeting, cardboard (moving boxes must be broken down), mattresses, and appliances (except for refrigerators, freezers, and air conditioning units, as noted above).

#### **Bulk Waste Do's and Don'ts**

- DO neatly stack bulk waste in a pile (not scattered), and away from vehicles, telephone poles, mailboxes, and other obstructions adjoining your property.
- DO bag small items.
- DO cut and roll carpet, padding, and rugs into 3-foot sections and tie or tape together.
- DO remove doors from appliances.
- DO extensively tape and cross tape any glass or mirrors to prevent from shattering.
- DO break down moving boxes.
- DON'T have carpet, padding, rug sections – or **ANY** waste -- exceed 40 pounds (appliances are an exception).

### **Yard Debris - Bags used for grass clippings can be paper or plastic.**

Yard debris includes inert and organic waste generated during regular household landscaping and gardening activities. The most common examples of yard waste are leaves, branches, twigs, shrubbery trimmings, pine straw, grass clippings, and Christmas trees.

#### **Yard Debris Do's and Don'ts**

- DO bag leaves during summer months (Mar. 1st-Oct. 31st).
- DO bag grass clippings year-round.
- DO bag shrubbery trimmings.
- DO separate yard debris from other solid waste.
- DO keep yard debris at least 3 feet away from other collection items and obstacles (mailboxes, poles, vehicles, etc.).
- DON'T place yard debris in the gutter or around any storm drain structure that may impede the flow of stormwater.
- DON'T block sidewalks with yard debris (or any other debris).
- DON'T place more than 15 bags at the curb for single collection.
- DON'T create bags that weigh more than 40 pounds.

#### **ITEMS WE DO NOT PICK UP:**

- Oil, batteries, tires, paint, hazardous chemicals, dirt, rocks, gravel, bricks, concrete blocks, stumps, shingles, refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, items more than 40 pounds (except appliances), any material/debris generated from a private contractor, and animal waste such as feces and/or animal carcasses.

**Please have waste placed curbside no earlier than the Sunday before your scheduled pickup.**

We are striving to improve the look of the City and ask for your help. Grass clippings not bagged, waste items not put out in accordance with these guidelines, and/or items placed curbside outside of the scheduled pickup dates may not be picked up and could result in Code Enforcement violations.

Thank you for your assistance as we do all we can to improve service to you.

There will be **NO** pickup on dates shaded in yellow – City Hall is closed one these date. Pickup will occur on the following business day.

Based on your address, crews will pick up yard waste and bulk waste according to the schedule below.

You must have items curbside no later than 6:30AM on MONDAY.
